Honorary State Regents Scholarship



History, Government or Political Science Scholarship

- Awarded to a college junior or senior attending an accredited college or university in the United States.
- Applicant shall have a concentrated study in History, Government or Political Science and/or proof of intent to teach history or government as shown on a transcript.
- The maximum award is \$2500.

Eligibility

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen and a resident of the State of Colorado and attend an accredited college or university in the United States. Applicants must obtain a letter of sponsorship from a Colorado DAR Chapter. Please do not submit a personal photograph as the scholarship is judged and awarded without regard to race, religion, sex, national origin, and disability. All awards are judged based on academic excellence, commitment to field of study (as required), and financial need by a committee of judges outside the NSDAR. The scholarship award is paid directly to the college or the university of winner's choice upon proof of registration. No person shall receive any scholarship award more than once.
